Treasurer's Report

Principals Report

Waiting to hear about last day of school. Nothing approved as of yet. Likely May 29th. Spring 5th grade field trip coming up-April 18. Spring pictures April 24th. Illinois Assessment of readiness currently being done. May 3 district day, no school for students. Teacher appreciation lunch on May 3. Field day May 20th. Looking for donations-volunteers needed. Sixth grade recognition 24th of May. Another round of emergency drills upcoming.

District data review - district wide. Includes SIPP plan, assessment data. Dr. Delamar presenting May 22nd at Wayne Elementary Library. Looking for feedback for improvements. Looking at data to improve students under 25% for learning. Dr. Delamar suggested presenting to the PTW beforehand, May 14th. Involves support for students' long term, including over summer break. Jana brings up point that programs like this should exist for kids who are over 25% but not at an ignite level as of yet. IXL has been a huge support for student improvement. Regular meetings with staff regarding status of intervention programs. Only 11 students in literacy intervention programs, 18 in math for grades 3 and above (literacy and math). Programs also include skills such as keyboarding. Funding not available for interventionists all year, teachers step in when interventionists are not available.

Teacher/Student Council Report

A countdown activity was presented by a student but board has reservations. Penny war was successful. Change was counted each day and made for a successful event. Mrs Wojnarowski was at bank for three hours to count all the change. \$1014.00 raised. Student council really enjoyed it, great leadership opportunity.

Student council invited by Food for Greater Hunger for celebration in change for hunger program.

Council made encouragement signs during testing. Asked about bathroom stalls. Cost an issue due to technology purchase. Dr Delamar. asked to review cost breakdown in hopes to get funding elsewhere. Discussion in terms of how to approach first phase...start with one stall, small parts of each, etc. Also concerns raised about students picking at vinyl stickers. Mrs Wojnarowski to look into paint versus vinyl adhesives. Erin to review resource for vinyl in West Chicago for donations of vinyl pieces.

Mrs Wojnarowski speaks about tile fundraiser. Concerns regarding quality of painted tiles. Advertise as parent/child/family legacy tile. Any non-appropriate tiles will not be posted.

May 10th 4pm-7pm for painting. Charge \$40.00 per tile. Presale blizzards and chocolate pretzels. Run a popcorn machine and donate water bottles. Supplies needed: water-based paint, hair dryers, table covers, sponges, trash bags, brushes, stencils, egg cartons for paint. Painting will be in multi-purpose room (SAFE needs to be moved elsewhere). Will also include a raffle for large cake squishy-\$1.00 per ticket. May 13th- 8:30am for tile placement. Note that this should not be an annual event.
